Finished Quilt Size: 72" x 72" Backing Required: 4½ yards

Batting Required: 80" x 80" piece of batting

Cutting Instructions

(WOF = Width of Fabric, HST = Half Square Triangle, QST = Quarter Square Triangle)

(Parallelogram Cutting Chart and Instructions shown on Page 3.)



Fabric A (44250 11): ¹/₄ yard (Cut Carefully)

- Cut (1) 81/2" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 1:
 - o (1) 81/2" square.
 - o (4) 4⁷/₈" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) HST.



Fabric B: (44251 11): ¾ yard

• Cut (2) 7¹/₄" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length. Trim the long strip to measure 71/4" x 653/4" for the Outer Border.



Fabric C: (44251 13): ¹/₄ yard (Cut Carefully)

- Cut (1) 81/2" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 3:
 - o (1) 81/2" square.
 - o (4) 4⁷/₈" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) HST.



Fabric D (44252 12): 6" (Cut Carefully)

• Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.



Fabric E (44252 13): 6" (Cut Carefully)

• Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.

• Set the remaining yardage aside for the HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric F (44252 14): ¹/₄ yard (Cut Carefully)

• Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 4:

○ (1) 8 ½″ square.

 \circ (4) 4⁷/₈" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) HST.



Fabric G (44253 11): ⁵/₈ yard

- Cut (2) 71/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length. Trim the long strip to measure 71/4" x 59" for the Outer Border.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric H (44253 12): ³/₈ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for the HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric I (44253 13): 1/8 yard

• Set yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric J (44253 15): ³/₈ yard

- Cut (1) 81/2" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 2:
 - o (1) 8½" square.
 - \circ (4) 4⁷/₈" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) HST.
- Cut (1) 11/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 11/2" x 11" strips. Use the Parallelogram Cutting Chart and Instructions to cut (4) P and (4) PR for Feathered Star Colorway 2.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for the HST Unit Instructions.



🖅 🔄 Fabric K (44254 11): ⁄ yard

- Cut (2) 7¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length. Trim the long strip to measure 7¼" x 72½" for the Outer Border.
- Cut (1) 11¼" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 4:
 - (1) 11¼" square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) QST.
 - o (4) 61/8" squares.
- Cut (4) 1¹/₈" x WOF strips. Trim (2) strips to 1¹/₈" x 21³/₄" unfinished and (2) strips to 1¹/₈" x 23" unfinished for Feathered Star Colorway 4.



🗾 Fabric L (44254 12): ¾ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric M (44255 15): 5⁄8 yard

• Cut (9) 2" x WOF strips. Leave (8) WOF strips whole. Subcut (2) 2" x 15" strips from the remaining strip. Set aside for 9-Patch Block Assembly.



Fabric N (44255 11): 7⁄8 yard

- Cut (2) 7¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length. Trim the long strip to measure 7¼" x 65¾" for the Outer Border.
- Cut (1) 11¼" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 1:
 - (1) 11¼" square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) QST.
 - o (4) 6¹/₈" squares.
- Cut (4) 1¹/₈" x WOF strips. Trim (2) strips to 1¹/₈" x 21³/₄" unfinished and (2) strips to 1¹/₈" x 23" unfinished for Feathered Star Colorway 1.



🗏 Fabric O (44255 12): ¾ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (3) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 1½" x 11" strips. Use the Parallelogram Cutting Chart and Instructions to cut (4) P and (4) PR for Feathered Star Colorway 1.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric P (44255 13): 7⁄8 yard

• Cut (8) 2¼" x WOF strips for binding.

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut the following:
 - $_{\odot}$ (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
 - (2) 1½" x 11" strips. Use the Parallelogram Cutting Chart and Instructions to cut (4) P and (4) PR for Feathered Star Colorway 4.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric Q (44255 14): ¼ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric R (44255 16): ¹/₈ yard

- Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 1½" x 11" strips. Use the Parallelogram Cutting Chart and Instructions to cut (4) P and (4) PR for Feathered Star Colorway 3.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric S (44255 21): 1³/₈ yard

- Cut (8) 2" x WOF strips. Leave (7) WOF strips whole. Trim (1) strip to measure 2" x 15". Set aside for 9-Patch Block Assembly.
- Cut (1) 1⁷/₈" x WOF strip. Subcut (16) 1⁷/₈" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (32) HST. Label for size.
- Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (16) 2" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (32) HST. Label for size.
- Cut (8) 21/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (128) 21/2" squares.



Fabric T (44256 12): ¹/₈ yard

• Set yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric U (44256 15): 1⁄8 yard

• Set yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.

Fabric V (44256 21): ³/₈ yard (Cut Carefully)

• Cut (1) 11¼" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 2 (see chart below):

 (1) 11¼" square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) QST.

- (4) 6¹/₈" squares.
- o (2) 1¹⁄⁄₃" x 21³⁄₄" strips.

o (2) 1¹/₃" x 23" strips.

Fabric W (44257 21): ³/₈ yard (*Cut Carefully*)

- Cut (1) 11¼" x WOF strip. Subcut the following for Feathered Star Colorway 3 (*refer to Fabric V cutting chart*):
 - (1) 11¼" square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) QST.
 - o (4) 6¹⁄₃″ squares.
 - o (2) 1¹⁄₃" x 21³⁄₄" strips.
 - o (2) 1¹⁄₃″ x 23″ strips.



Fabric X (44257 22): $\frac{1}{8}$ yard (Cut Carefully)

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



Fabric Y (44257 23): $^3\!\!/_8$ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.



🎫 Fabric Z (44257 24): ¼ yard

- Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares for Quilt Assembly.
- Set the remaining yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.

Fabric AA (44257 25): 1⁄8 yard

• Set yardage aside for HST Unit Instructions.

Parallelogram Cutting Chart & Instructions:

Layer (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" matching print strips right sides together to make a strip set. First, trim the left side of the strip set to a 45° angle. Cut (4) $1\frac{5}{6}$ " wide parallelograms from the strip set to produce (4) parallelograms (P) and (4) parallelograms reversed (PR). Layering the strips right sides together ensure that the cuts will produce both P and PR at the same time. Cut the following:

- Fabric J: For Colorway 2
- Fabric P: For Colorway 4
- Fabric O: For Colorway 1
- Fabric R: For Colorway 3

.



Assembly:

Unless otherwise noted, all seams are a scant 1/4".

Making the HST Units:

Step 1. First, cut an assortment of (128) 2½" squares from the following fabrics: **Fabrics E, G, H, I, J, L, O, P, Q, R, T, U, X, Y, Z,** and **AA.** (*Please note: If you wish to use specific fabrics for Feathered Star Colorways* 1-4, cut the appropriate quantity of 2½" squares based on the 2-at-a-time HST Unit piecing method. If you wish to make HST units completely scrappy, cut between 8-9 squares from each print.)

Step 2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (128) Fabric S 2½" squares.

Step 3. Place (1) Fabric S $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square with (1) print fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from either side of the drawn diagonal line.

Step 4. Cut along the drawn line, separating the two sides and creating (2) HST units. Press the seams open.

Step 5. Repeat to make (256) HST units. Trim (144) HST units to measure 1%" x 1%" unfinished. Trim the remaining (112) HST units to measure 1%" x 1%" unfinished.



Making the Feathered Stars:

(Feathered Star Assembly diagrams and instructions are shown using Colorway 1 as a guide. Repeat instructions to cut (1) of each Feathered Star Colorways 2-4. Reference the cutting instructions and diagrams for accurate fabric combinations.)

Step 6. Parallelogram Assembly: Gather (4) P and (4) PR from Fabric O, and (8) Fabric S 1⁷/₈" HST. Sew the longest edge of (1) Fabric S HST to each parallelogram as shown. Please note the difference between P units and PR units. Set aside for Feathered Star Colorway 1.



Step 7. Repeat to make P units and PR units for Fabric J (*Colorway 2*), Fabric R (*Colorway 3*) and Fabric P (*Colorway 4*).

Step 8. Side Units: Select an assortment of (28) 1½" HST units and (36) 1%" HST units for Feathered Star Colorway 1 (either scrappy or planned HST unit placement).

Step 9. Sew (4) 1⁵/₈" HST units and (1) Fabric S 2" HST into a row as shown. Sew the row to one side of (1) Fabric N 111/4" QST using a partial seam.



Step 10. Sew (5) 1[™] HST units and (1) Fabric S 2" HST into a row as shown. Sew the row to one side of the same Fabric N 11[™] QST using a partial seam. Make (4) Side Units.



Step 11. Sew the longest edges of (2) Fabric A 4⁷/₆" HST to each Side Unit. Press toward Fabric A.



Step 12. Corner Units: Sew (3) 1½" HST units and a P unit (*Fabrics O and S*) to make a row as shown. Press seams open.



Step 13. Sew (4) 1½" HST units and a PR unit (*Fabrics O and S*) to make another row as shown. Press seams open.

Step 14. Sew the row made in Step 12 to one side of (1) Fabric N 61%" square. Then sew the row made in Step 13 to the side of the same square. Press toward the square. Make (4) Corner Units.





Step 15. Arrange the Side and Corner Units made for Colorway 1 and (1) Fabric A 8½" square. First, sew together in (3) horizontal rows. Sew the seams that are indicated by the heavy lines in the numbered order given to complete the partial seams.

Step 16. Sew the horizontal rows together in the same manner. Trim to measure 21¾" x 21¾" unfinished.





Step 17. Sew (1) Fabric N 1%" x 21%" strip onto either side of the block. Press outward. Sew (1) Fabric N 1%" x 23" strip onto the top and bottom of the block. Press outward to complete the Feathered Star Colorway 1 Block. The block should measure 23" x 23" unfinished.



Step 18. Repeat the Feathered Star Assembly instructions provided above to make (1) of each Colorway 2-4. See the block examples below labeled with accurate fabric placement. Each completed Feathered Star Block should measure 23" x 23" unfinished.

Making the 9-Patch Units:

Step 19. Make Strip Set A. Sew (1) Fabric M 2" x WOF strip to either side of (1) Fabric S 2" x WOF strip. Press toward Fabric M. Make (3) Strip Set A and (1) smaller Strip Set A with strips measuring 2" x 15".

Step 20. Subcut Strip Set A into (66) 2" x 5" units. Label as Unit A.



Step 21. Make Strip Set B. Sew (1) Fabric S 2" x WOF strip to either side of (1) Fabric M 2" x WOF strip. Press toward Fabric M. Make (2) Strip Set B.

Step 22. Subcut Strip Set B into (33) 2" x 5" units. Label as Unit B.



Step 23. Complete 9-Patch Unit assembly by sewing (1) Unit A onto either side of (1) Unit B. The 9-Patch Unit should measure 5" x 5" unfinished. Repeat to make (33) identical 9-Patch Units.





Assembling the Quilt Top:

Step 24. Arrange Feathered Star Block Colorways 1-4, 9-Patch Units and assorted 5" squares as shown. Either use the quilt images for exact 5" square placement, or place randomly. Sew the quilt top together in rows, pressing toward the 5" squares and away from the Feathered Star Blocks.

Step 25. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top center. The quilt top center should measure 59" x 59" unfinished.

Step 26. First, attach (1) Fabric G 7¼" x 59" border strip to the left side of the quilt top center. Press outward.

Step 27. Second, attach (1) Fabric N 7¼" x 65¾" border strip to the bottom of the quilt top center. Press outward.

Step 28. Third, attach (1) Fabric B 7¼" x 65¾" border strip to the right side of the quilt top center. Press outward.

Step 29. Last, attach (1) Fabric K $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the top of the quilt top center. This completes assembly. The quilt top should measure $72\frac{1}{2}$ " x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

Step 30. Quilt and Bind as desired.
