## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Label all the pieces as they are cut.

## 1 Fat Eighth of each

From each of the fabrics, cut the following:

- 2 strips $-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$
- Subcut 8 squares $-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime} .52$ squares are needed; you will have 4 left over.


## Pink Prints for Star Points and Border Blocks

1 Fat Quarter of each
From each of the fabrics, cut the following:

- 2 strips $-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 21$ ".
- Subcut 8 squares $-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
- 1 strip - $71_{4}$ " $^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$.
- Subcut 2 squares $-7 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ ".

10 squares are needed; you will have 2 leftover.

Aqua Prints for Block Centers and Border Triangles


## 1 Fat Quarter of each

From each of the fabrics, cut the following:

- 1 strip $-43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$.
- Subcut 4 squares $-43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- 1 strip - $71_{4}$ " $^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$.
- Subcut 2 squares $-71_{4}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 71_{4}$ ". 10 blocks are needed; you will have 2 left over.


## Aqua Prints for Block Centers

## 1 Fat Eighth

- Cut 1 strip $-43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$.
- Subcut 4 squares $-43 / 4$ " $\times 43 / 4$ ".


## Ivory Prints for Block <br> Backgrounds and Border Blocks



- Cut 1 strip - $71 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 42$ ".
- From the strip, cut 4 squares $-71^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ ".
- Cut 2 strips $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$.
- From the strips, cut 16 squares $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.
- Cut 4 strips $-67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$.
- From each strip, subcut 5 squares $-67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, and 1 square $-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Cut 1 strip -4" $\times 42$ ".
- From the strip, cut 6 squares $-4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$.


## Ivory Prints - cont.



## $2 / 3$ yard each

From each of the fabrics, cut the following:

- 2 strips $-71_{4}$ " $^{\prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$.
- From the 1 st strip, cut 5 squares $-71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- From the 2 nd strip, cut 1 square $-7 \frac{1}{4}$ " $^{x}$ $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- From the remainder, cut 2 strips $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ approx. 32".
- From each strip, cut 9 squares $-31_{1}^{\prime \prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.
- 1 strip - 4" $\times 42$ "
- Subcut 8 squares $-4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- 1 strip - $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$.
- Subcut 6 squares $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$. (24 total.)


## 4422611 1⁄2 yard

- Cut 1 strip -71/4" $\times 42$ ".
- From the strip, cut 3 squares $-71_{1} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- From the remainder, cut 2 strips $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ approx. 18".
- Subcut 10 squares $-31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ ".
- Cut 1 strip - 4" $\times 42$ ".
- From the strip, cut 6 squares, 4 " $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$
- From the remainder, cut 2 squares, $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.

- Cut 4 squares - 4" $\times 4$ " from each.

Binding - Cut 8 strips - $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$

## ASSEMBLY

All seams are a scant $1 / 4 \mathrm{~L}$.
There are 12 pink stars and 13 taupe/gray stars.
Each star block uses two different ivory prints.
All 25 stars have an aqua center square.
For each block, you will need the following pieces:

- Ivory Print for Background: 1 square $-71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and 2 matching squares $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Pink or Taupe/Gray: 4 matching squares $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
- Ivory Print for Center Triangles:

2 squares - 4" $\times 4$ ".

- Aqua Print: 1 square $-43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.


## Making the Flying Geese

Draw a diagonal line as shown on the wrong side of the four pink (or taupe/ gray) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares using a permanent
 pen, pencil, or fabric marker.

With right sides together, align two of the squares in opposing corners of the ivory $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " $^{\prime \prime}$ square as shown.


Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on both sides of the line.

Cut the square apart on the drawn line.
Press the seams toward the small triangles.



With right sides together, align one of the remaining squares on each ivory triangle as shown.

Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on both sides of the line. Cut the triangle apart on the drawn line. Press the seams toward the small triangle to make four matching flying geese units that should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Repeat to make 25 sets of 4 matching flying geese, 12 pink and 13 taupe/ gray.


## Making the Square-In-a-Square Units

Select 2 matching 4" $\times 4$ " ivory print squares and 1 aqua $43 / 4$ " $\times 43 / 4$ " square.

Cut both 4" squares of ivory print 2 in half once on the diagonal as shown to yield four
 triangles.
Join two triangles to opposing sides of the aqua $43 / 4$ " square.

Press the seams to the triangle.


To get proper 31/4"
placement - align the points of corners of the aqua square with the $31 / 4$ " lines on the ruler. Then trim the pieced unit to measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.


Make 25 units.

## Assembling the Star Blocks

Lay out the units and the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for the corner squares.


Join the pieces to make three rows.
Press all seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.

Join the rows to complete the block.


The block will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Repeat to make 12 blocks with Pink star points and 13 blocks with Taupe/Gray star points.

## Making the Border Blocks

Cut the 10 aqua squares and 10 pink $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares twice on the diagonal as shown to yield 40 aqua triangles and 40 pink triangles.


Join a pink and aqua triangle as shown.


Press the seam open.
Repeat to make 20 pieced A triangles. Join one aqua and one pink triangle as shown.


Press the seam open.
Repeat to make 20 pieced $B$ triangles.
Cut the 20 ivory print $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half on the diagonal to yield 40 triangles.


## Border Square A

Join 1 ivory print triangle to one pieced A triangle as shown.


The square will measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Repeat to make 20 A squares.

## Border Square B

Join 1 ivory print triangle to one pieced $B$ triangle as shown.


The square will measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Repeat to make 20 B squares.

## Border Rectangles

Join 1 A Square to 1 B Square as shown.


Press the seam to one side - or press it open.
The border rectangle will measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Repeat to make 20 border rectangles.

## ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP

Assemble the quilt in seven rows - the top and bottom border rows, and five block rows that include a border rectangle at each end.

Join the blocks to complete the rows. Press the seams in one direction, alternating the direction with each row, or press the seams open..

Using a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, join the rows to complete the quilt top. Press the seams in one direction, or press them open.

The quilt top will measure $72 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
We recommend stay-stitching the edges of quilt tops that have a outer pieced borders. To staystitch the edge, simply stitch around the quilt top approximately $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ away from the raw edge with a regular stitch length.

Quilt and bind as desired.
