Tochi Panel Blue 1 Full Panel Tochi Panel Gold 1 Full Panel
Tochi Panel Grey $1 / 2$ Panel
Background $21 / 8$ yards Bella solids white 9900-98 or black 9900-99

I starched my fabrics heavily before cutting to increase accuracy in piecing.
From the Blue Tochi panel cut (36) $53 / 4$ " squares.
From the Gold Tochi panel cut (28) $53 / 4$ " squares.
From the Grey Tochi panel cut (20) $53 / 4$ " squares.
From the background fabric cut (12) $53 / 4$ " strips selvage to selvage. Subcut (7) $53 / 4$ " squares from each strip.
Pair each Tochi square with a background square. Draw a line corner to corner on the lighter of the two squares and sew $1 / 4$ " away from the line on both sides of the line. Cut on the line. Press the seam toward the darker side. Square up to be a 5 " half square triangle unit. You will have 168 half square triangle units. Use all of the units to layout and sew the quilt together in rows. Press the seams in each row in opposite directions. Sew the rows together, quilt and bind.


After making your 168 half square triangle units you can play with alternate ways to put the quilt together. Below are just a few of many examples.


## Halfway Around the World

Very simple to make quilt using the Tochi panels. It is entirely half square triangles for a scrappy quilt. I cut my squares oversize and used a Bloc Loc 5 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangle ruler to square them up. You can cut to size or use a different square up ruler.
