

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

35% YARDS - BELLA SOLIDS, BUBBLE GUM BLOCKS, SETTING TRIANGLES

31/8 YARDS - BELLA SOLIDS, OFF WHITE BLOCKS



9900 200

5/8 YARD - BINDING

43/4 YARDS - BACKING

SUPPLIES-

(1) CAKE MIX RECIPE 4 FOUNDATION RECIPE CARDS



84" × 84" PIECE OF BATTING

CUTTING-

WOF = Width of Fabric (approx. 42")

FROM THE BUBBLE GUM BELLA SOLID:

Cut (10) 10" × WOF strips. From strips, cut:

- (39) 10" × 10" squares

Cut (3) 71/4" × WOF strips. From strips, cut:

- (13) 71/4" × 71/4" squares. Cut each square in half twice diagonally for 52 setting triangles.

FROM THE OFF WHITE BELLA SOLID:

Cut (10) 10" × WOF strips. From strips, cut:

- (39) 10" × 10" squares

FROM THE BINDING FABRIC:

Cut (8) 21/2" × WOF strips

MAKING THE BLOCK UNITS

Fabrics are sewn with right sides together. Refer to this video where Lissa Alexander shows you how to use the Cake Mix Recipe papers.

HST = Half-square Triangle

- 1. Layer one *Off White* 10" square onto a *Bubble Gum* 10" square. Lining up the edges of the fabric squares, pin a *Cake Mix Recipe 4* recipe card on top.
- 2. You will be making the 4" × 4" finished HST units. Beginning at the star, stitch the layers together on the dashed lines in the direction of the arrows.
- 3. Cut apart using the solid lines. Press seams toward the darker fabric, gently tear away the paper, and trim away the points to make eight $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ " HST units.
- 4. Repeat to stitch a total of 39 recipe cards to make 312 HST units.






ASSEMBLY AND FINISHING


Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Press all seams open.

5. Lay out 13 Bubble Gum setting triangles and 78 HST units, as shown. *Pay attention to the changing orientation of the HST units beginning with the fourth row.* Sew together into rows. Sew the rows together to make a large triangle. Triangle measures approximately 52% × 52%. Make 4.



Refer to the quilt assembly diagram on page 4.

- 6. Lay out the four large triangles, as shown. Join together into rows. Join the rows together to make the Peach Cobbler quilt top measuring approximately 74" × 74".
- 7. Prepare backing. Layer, baste, and quilt as desired.
- 8. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
- 9. Sew the eight binding strips together into one long strip using diagonal seams. Bind the edges of the quilt to finish. Enjoy!
