

#### HOW TO:

# MAKE HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES 8-FROM-ONE METHOD

### **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 Layer Cake® squares
- · Pencil or other marking tool

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**


- Draw a pencil line across both diagonals of one 1 Layer Cake® square (shown as solid line).
- **?** Place 2 Layer Cake® squares right sides together.





- **3** Sew ½" seam on each side of the diagonal marks (shown as dashed lines).
- 4 Cut Layer Cake® squares apart on EACH pencil line, creating four triangles.

**5** Cut EACH of the 4 triangles in half as shown, creating a total of 8 triangles.



Press towards the darker fabric and trim to 4½" square.

## **YIELD**

Two Layer Cake® squares make (8) 4½" half square triangles.
