



INGREDIENTS

- · 1 Fat Eighth bundle
- 11/4 yards background + border 1
- ½ yard border 2
- 1 yard border 3
- · 4 yards backing
- ½ yard binding



SAWTOOTH STARS: Select 13 fat eighths for Stars and 13 fat eighths for Star backgrounds.

GREEK SQUARES: Select 6 medium fat eighths and 6 dark fat eighths.



1 CUTTING From each of 13 Star fat eighths, cut:

- (1) 5½" square
- (4) 3%" squares

From each of 13 Star Background fat eighths, cut:

- (1) 61/4" square
- (2) 3%" squares

From each of 6 medium fat eighths, cut (1) 51/2" square From each of the 6 dark fat eighths, cut:

- (4) 13/4" x 51/2" rectangles
- (2) 3%" squares

From background fabric, cut:

- (5) 3%" x WOF strips; subcut into (50) 3%" squares
- (2) 5½" x WOF strips; subcut into (48) 1¾" x 5½" rectangles
- (6) 2½" x WOF strips (set aside for Border 1) From border 2 fabric, cut (6) 1½" x WOF strips From border 3 fabric, cut (8) 4½" x WOF strips

 ↑ SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCKS: Half Square Triangles Lagrangian Draw a diagonal pencil line on the wrong side of a 3%" background square. Place right sides together with a 3%" star background square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of pencil line. Cut apart on the pencil line. Press each unit and trim to 3" square. Repeat to make a total of 52 Half Square Triangles.



SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCKS: Flying Geese NOTE: These instructions are for the no-waste method.


Gather (1) 61/4" outer star square and (4) 33/4" inner star squares.Draw a diagonal line on the back of all of the smaller squares. Line up two smaller squares along the diagonal of a larger square, right sides together (the middles will overlap).








Sew 1/4" away from the center line on both sides. Cut on the center line. Press the units, pressing the seam allowance toward the smaller triangles. Take care not to distort the fabric when pressing.















Line a smaller square up with the corner as shown. Sew 1/4" away from the center line on both sides. Cut on the center line.





Press the units toward the smaller triangles. Again, take care not to distort the fabric when pressing. Trim to size. Each unit should measure 3" by 5.5" unfinished. Repeat to make a total of 52 flying geese.

A SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Gather 4 HST, 4 flying geese, and the 5½" inner star square. Assemble the block as shown.

Make a total of 13 Sawtooth Star blocks. The blocks measure 10½" unfinished.





5 GREEK SQUARE: Half Square Triangles

Follow the nstructions from Step 2 to make HSTs using the dark 3%" squares and 3%" squares of background fabric. Make a total of 48 HSTs.

GREEK SQUARE BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Gather 4 HST, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (4 dark and 4 background), and $5\frac{1}{2}$ " center square. Assemble the block as shown.





Make a total of 12 Greek Square blocks. The blocks measure 10½" unfinished.

7 QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Once your blocks are made, lay them out as shown below. Sew the blocks together in 5 rows of 5. Sew the rows together.



8 BORDERS

• Sew each round of border strips together endto-end. to make 1 long strip per border. Press and starch. Cut into the lengths listed.

	BORDER 1	BORDER 2	BORDER 3
SIDES	(2) 2½" x	(2) 1½" x	(2) 4½" x
	50½" strips	54½" strips	56½" strips
TOP +	(2) 2½" x	(2) 1½" x	(2) 4½" x
BOTTOM	54½" strips	56½" strips	64½" strips

Attach side borders first, press, and then attach top and bottom borders.

9 FINISHING THE QUILT Baste, quilt, and bind the quilt using as preferred.
